AIC Policy Committee and Task Force Service

The AIC Board of Directors has determined that only members in good standing of AIC can serve as regular members of AIC committees and task forces, including members of specialty group committees and task forces. AIC committees and task forces are approved by the board (or specialty group officers, as appropriate), receive an appropriate budget to accomplish their approved charge, and, typically, accomplish their work through the use of AIC listservs and phone conferencing services.

Only current members, such as board members or specialty group officers, have access to information about how to work effectively within AIC's policies and procedures. It is appropriate that only dues-paying members provide guidance and promote the goals of the organization through work on a committee or task force.

With board-approval, committees and task forces can include non-members who provide a specific expertise not provided by members. These non-members are given a particular role suited to their expertise and are supported in their volunteer service to AIC.
