SUBJECT: 2009 TSG Treasurer's Report (2008 Fiscal Year – 1/1/08 – 12/31/08)

I thank my TSG Officer colleagues for presenting my Report on my behalf. It has been a pleasure working with all of them this past year. I look forward to working with them in the coming year. I also thank my predecessor, Sarah Stevens, for her mentoring and impeccably kept TSG 'books'.

In brief, during the 2008 Fiscal Year, the Textile Specialty Group continued to spend more than it brought in for the 2nd year in a row, drawing down on the reserves built up in past years. Unfortunately, I don't see that this trend will change.

TSG has little control over the expenses associated with the Annual Meeting. Only estimates are provided by the AIC Office for the expenses of the audio-visual equipment and technician costs (account #874), coffee breaks the whole week (the amount charged TSG is based on TSG membership size) and the TSG business meeting breakfast (account #880). The actual costs are only known months after the Annual Meeting, making it very difficult to budget for ahead of time. For example, these two categories cost \$4,742.32 alone for the 2008 Annual Meeting held in Denver. The TSG revenue for 2008 was \$9,100.50, meaning these categories used 52% of the TSG revenue. The TSG Dinner is budgeted to break even. TSG may also be charged for meeting room space at Annual Meetings in the near future (at next year's Annual Meeting in Milwaukee, WI?).

The TSG publication schedule for 2009 is the Annual Meeting Postprints (CD format) and two more chapters of the TSG Catalog. I thank the editors of these projects for continuing to pinch every penny possible. The recent increase in postal rates will increase the cost of these 3 projects. During 2008, the AIC Office also copied previous published TSG Catalog chapters when sales stocks ran low for another unexpected/uncontrolled TSG expense (account#816). At least this expense was at least partially offset by the revenue generated by the sale of these publications.

Beginning with the 2009 Fiscal Year, our donations to the FAIC Individual Professional Development fund and to the FAIC George Stout fund are increased to \$1000 each, per the motion passed at the 2007 TSG Business Meeting.
