ANNOTATED SHORTLIST EMERGENCY SUPPLIES

**Personal protection and supplies that may be needed for a “Re-entry Team”
(when first responders declare the building safe):**

- first-aid kit
- eye protection
- hardhats
- respiratory protection as appropriate
- steel toed boots (e.g. Redwing)
- hearing protection
- work gloves
- Tyvek suit
- waterproof flashlight
- camera (extra batteries, etc. as needed)
- cell phone and charging cord with car adapter
- clipboard and paper or notebook with waterproof pen

Wear nitrile gloves then put on work gloves

Water proof paper/notebooks – RiteIntheRain.com

Mechanical pencils

Flashlight – LED type; extra batteries

Headlamp – LED type

Light source (battery powered) that can be clamped

Power banks (for cell phones/tablets)

Tape to tape Tyvek suit legs tight at cuffs

‘Croakie’-type cord to hold eye protection/personal eyeglasses so can’t fall off

Trash bags when disrobing Tyvek suit

Use video mode of cell phone to record scene – narrate as video

Personal protection that may be needed by a collections salvage team:

- respiratory protection, as advised
- nitrile gloves
- waterproof aprons or pants
- knee pads

Knee pads from polyethylene foam (light in weight; water proof; cheap)

Eye protection still (against splashing while rinsing/moving objects)

‘Croakie’-type cord to hold eye protection/personal eyeglasses so can’t fall off

Basic salvage materials for a small to moderate event:

- wet/dry vacuums
- dehumidifiers
- fans
- roll of plastic sheeting at least 2 mil thick
- tarps
- packing tape/duct tape
- plastic crates, Rescubes or cardboard boxes (trash-bag linings)
- waterproof flashlights (extra batteries)
- power strips, extension cords
- mops, squeegees
- work lights
- pocket knife, box cutter, Leatherman
- battery operated screwdriver
- wax paper or parchment paper
- plastic trash bags
- Mylar
- Tyvek
- polyethylene bags
- terrycloth towels
- blotting paper, unprinted newsprint, paper towels
- extra batteries
- waterproof markers or pens
- labels
- camera (extra batteries, etc. as needed)
- scissors

Flat sheets – pillowcases – twin to king sizes

Polyethylene bags - could be clear large (33 gallon and up) trash bags

Battery powered LED work lights – Ott brand also colour balanced (camping equipment stores)

Water proof paper/notebooks – RiteInTheRain.com

Power banks (for cell phones/tablets)

Trash bags – clear, not black or white so no mistakes

Pair of scissors for each item that needs to be cut (sheeting; tapes; papers; Mylar; Tyvek; twine)

Polyethylene plastic sheeting 2mil thick or less (for separating and stuffing); 4 mil (for support while being moved)

Polyethylene top folding tables – adjustable height – Brands: Lifetime Iceberg
