# *Results from our Meetings*

- Power will be out for days, or weeks
- Fuel will run out in 3 days
- Shelters will be needed for 62,000 people
- Hospitals will be at capacity immediately
- Water and Waste Water systems will be down for weeks

# *How To Proceed*



- Develop/update COOP Plan
  - Internal emergency contact information
  - Who is in charge of what?
  - Liaison for private sector stakeholders in EOC
- Use CERT model
  - Make use of “Team” concept
  - Assigned roles/responsibilities w/o communication
- Be proactive in protection of collections/items
  - Make diagrams, maps, & prioritized inventory list available at each location
