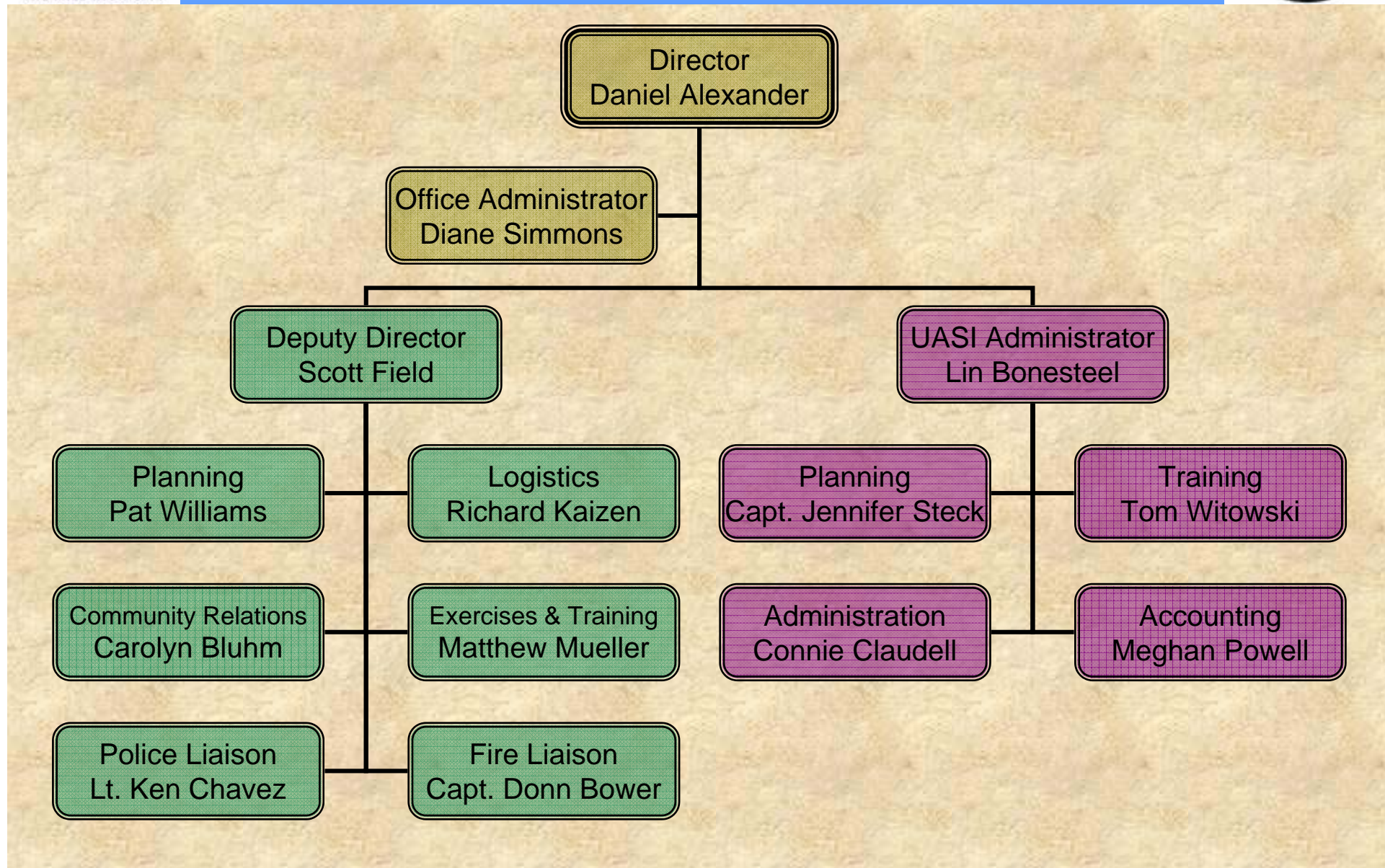

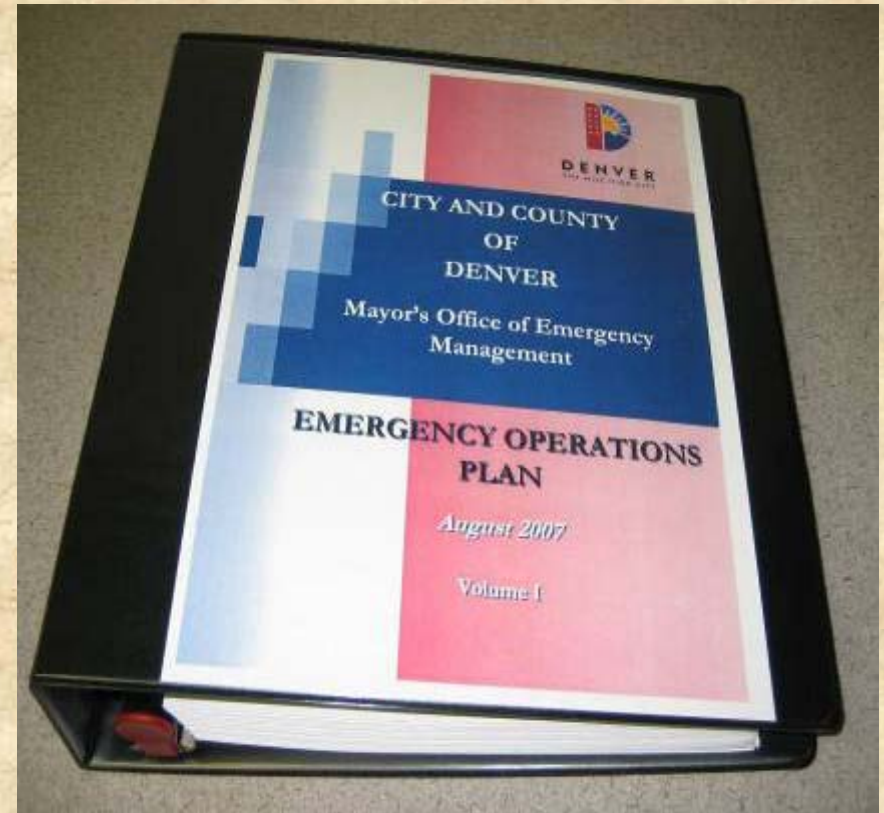


Emergency Operations Plan



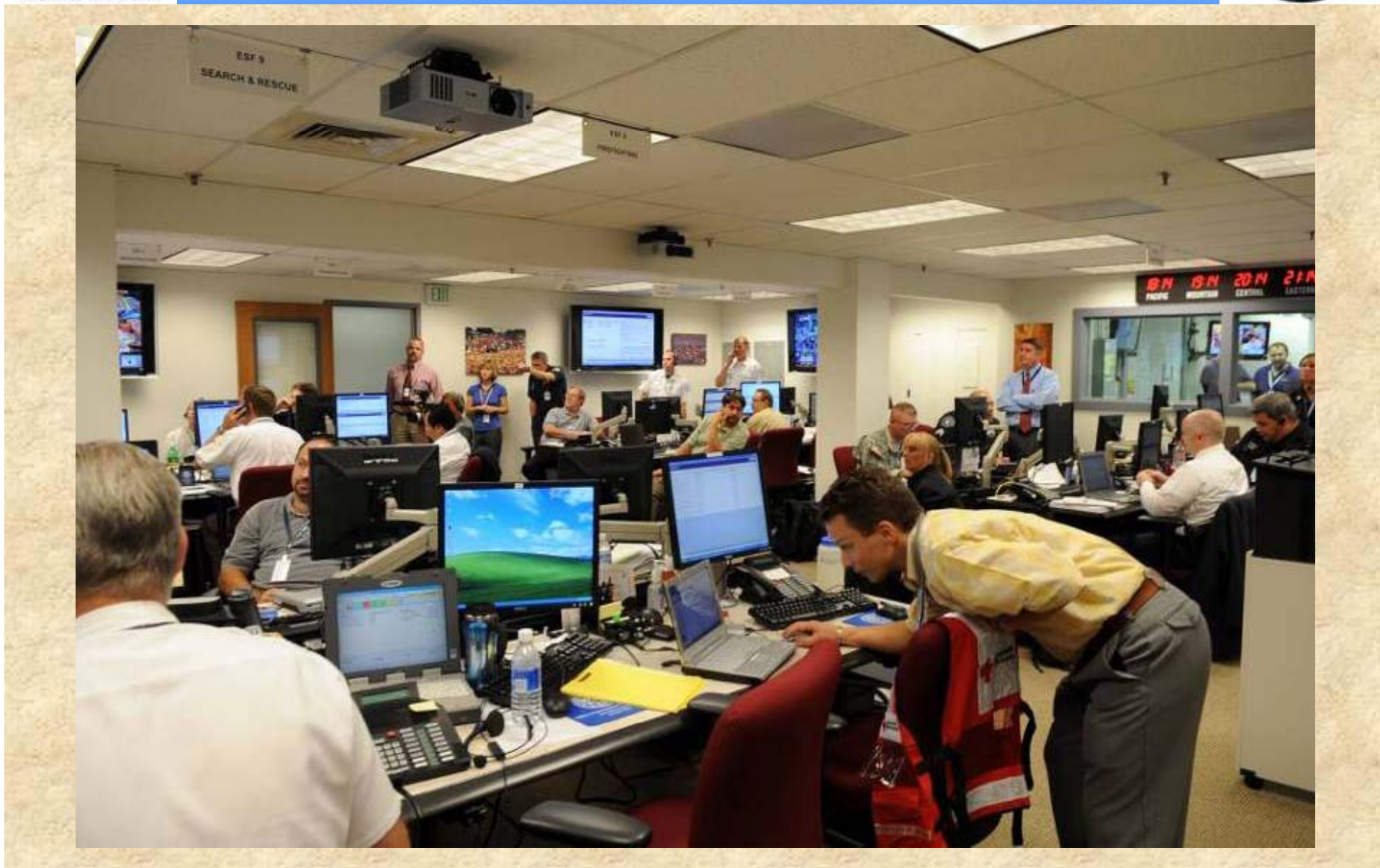
